<p>Applicants are responsible for reading the full text of the NWPCG Scholarship Procedures. The abbreviated summary of rules is as follows.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A person must be a member of the Guild in good standing (see Appendix A), for a minimum of 6 months. 2. Scholarships are based on financial need. 3. All awarded scholarships are non-transferable and event specific. 4. Clay Camp tuition scholarships can be awarded for up to 75% of the total cost only. This is exclusive of any extra classes that may be offered during a Clay Camp event. 5. A scholarship award for class tuition may be up to 50% of the class cost total. Class tuition scholarships are limited to three scholarship awards per class/workshop unless directed by a Board vote. 6. The maximum number of scholarships allowed for a Clay Camp event is five total unless directed by a Board vote. 7. No member will be awarded more than two scholarships per year. 8. The due date for applications will be two months before the event unless otherwise specified by the NWPCG Board of Directors.
