



## CLAY CAMP May 14-17, 2010

**LOCATION:** Camp Houston, Conference Center, Gold Bar, Washington

**TIME:** Arrive **AFTER** 4 p.m., Fri, May 14, 2010 - **Depart by** 2:00 p.m. Mon, May 17, 2010

**MEALS:** Family style, begin with dinner on Friday at 7pm and end with Monday lunch. Breakfast is at 8am, Lunch is 12:30 pm and Dinner is 6 pm except for Friday.

**LODGING:** We will be using two cabins. One is designated for campers that like to go to bed earlier. The other cabin will be for all those wild folks who like to stay up real late (curfew on noise in the cabin is 2 a.m.). Each cabin has a common area with a fireplace. Each room has two single beds with two chairs and two clothes hanging racks on the walls. The rooms are carpeted with a window. There are two bathrooms in each cabin. If you wish to room with a particular person, please note that on the registration form. Room assignments will be done ahead of time. All rooms are non-smoking.

**WHAT IS PROVIDED:** There will be work tables and chairs. The guild will supply a first aid kit, power strips and extension cords and the guild buffer.

**WHAT TO BRING:** You will need to bring your own sheets, blankets or sleeping bag, towels, soap, etc. **NO LINENS ARE AVAILABLE AT CAMP**

The common area in each cabin has a refrigerator and microwave. Bring your own snacks, pop, etc. Tea and hot chocolate are available in each cabin and the main building. The walls are thin so earplugs are suggested.

Bring your polymer tools, work surface (a must!), blades, pasta machines, etc. The chairs are low, so you might want to bring a pillow to sit on and there are some pillows available at the camp. Lighting in the workroom is not great so you may want to bring a work lamp for the table.

There are wooded walking paths, so if the weather is nice bring your walking shoes. Camp Houston is right next to Wallace Falls State Park so there is another spot to take a nature break.

**SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:** The work area is open 24 hours.

**Demos:** We will have scheduled demos. If you specifically want to see something or if you would like to share something, let the camp organizers know before the registration deadline date.

**Mini-classes:** We will have a couple of mini-classes on Sat and Sun. The classes will be available for an additional cost. Class details will be announced prior to camp and signups for classes will be taken at camp.

**Brown Bag Exchange:** Saturday after dinner we will have a Brown Bag Exchange. Bring something polymer related (or not!), that will fit into a brown paper lunch sack. If you bring an item for the bag you will get to pick a bag in the hilarious Brown Bag Exchange. This is **NOT** a White Elephant exchange. Please bring something that you believe someone would enjoy receiving.

**Non-affle raffle:** Held Sat. night after dinner. Non-affle tickets are available for a \$1 donation each. We need items donated so people have something to win. If you would like to donate just bring your items to camp with you. Donated items can be anything you think someone want to win.

### ADDITIONAL INFO

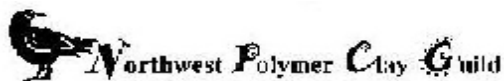
