I am pleased to say that our January work-a-long was a success. We had better than expected attendance and the things that everyone made were amazing! This month we will be having the official Guild meeting with the work-a-long on February 5th at our regular noon time. After discussion at the last meeting it was decided that the mystery aspect was really not necessary and that the participants would generally like more time to think about color choices and that type of thing. That being said, this month we will be making the above pictured multi-layered pendants. The materials you will need are:

- Solid light colored clay – I used an ecru color in all three of the examples. If you are going to use a really slick surfaced clay like Kato, it is a good idea to have some Ultralight or Souffle to add to it
- Black clay for the backing and bail
- Large to small cutters of any shape that you like to use together to give the different layers. If you don't have cutters that you like, these shapes can be cut out with an exacto knife
- Tools for texture – the main tools I used in the examples were my exacto knife, ball stylus and the smallest Etch-n-Pearl tool. I also used some random square and round metal tubes.
- Acrylic Paint – whatever colors you like plus a dark brown/black, white and gold
