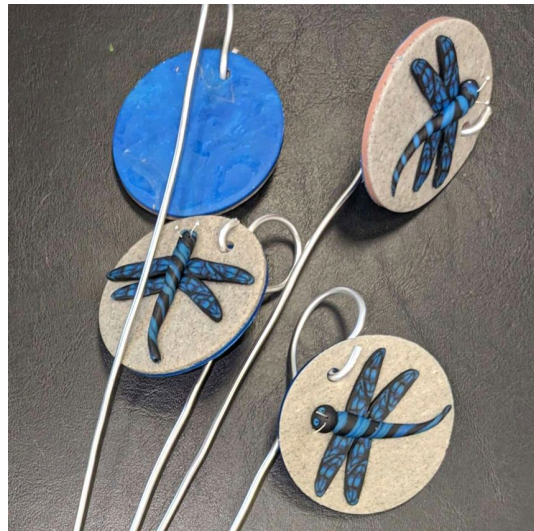
Things with Wings Swap

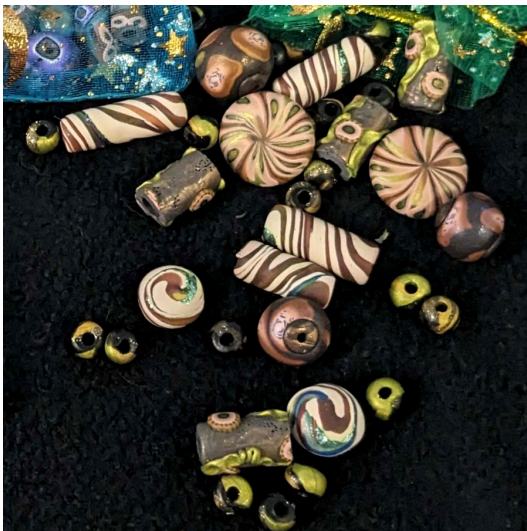

We tried out a mini swap in February, with eight participants. Due to health issues and possibly some miscommunication, the swap didn't take place until Clay Camp. Here are the pics!



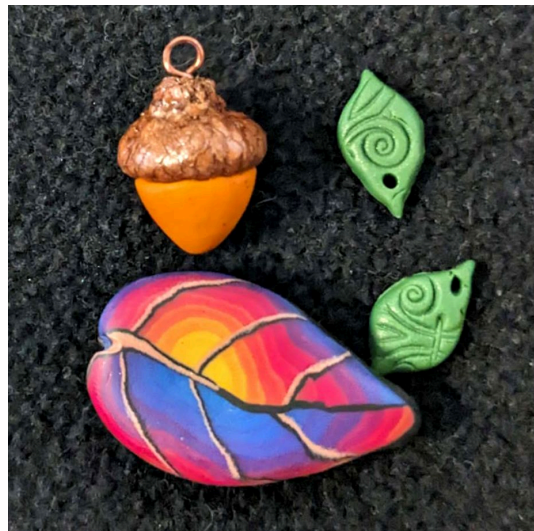

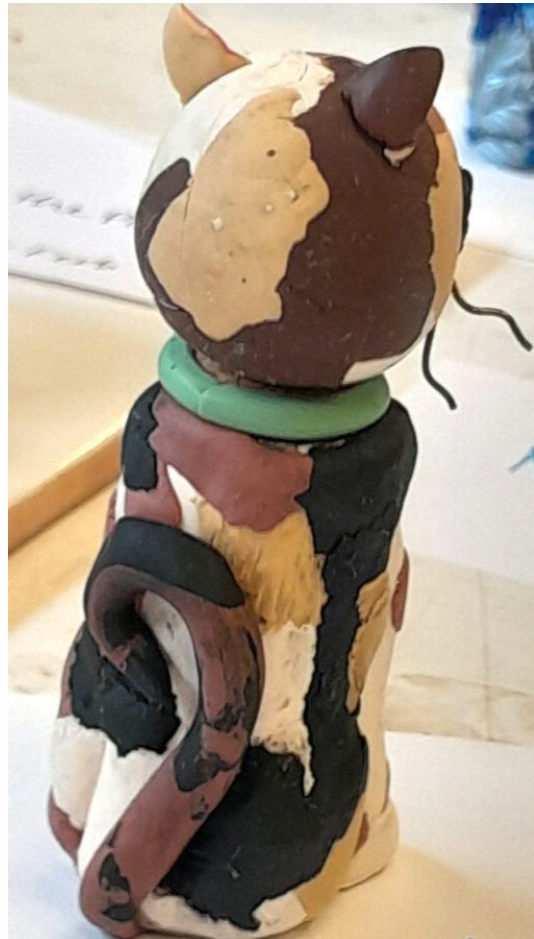

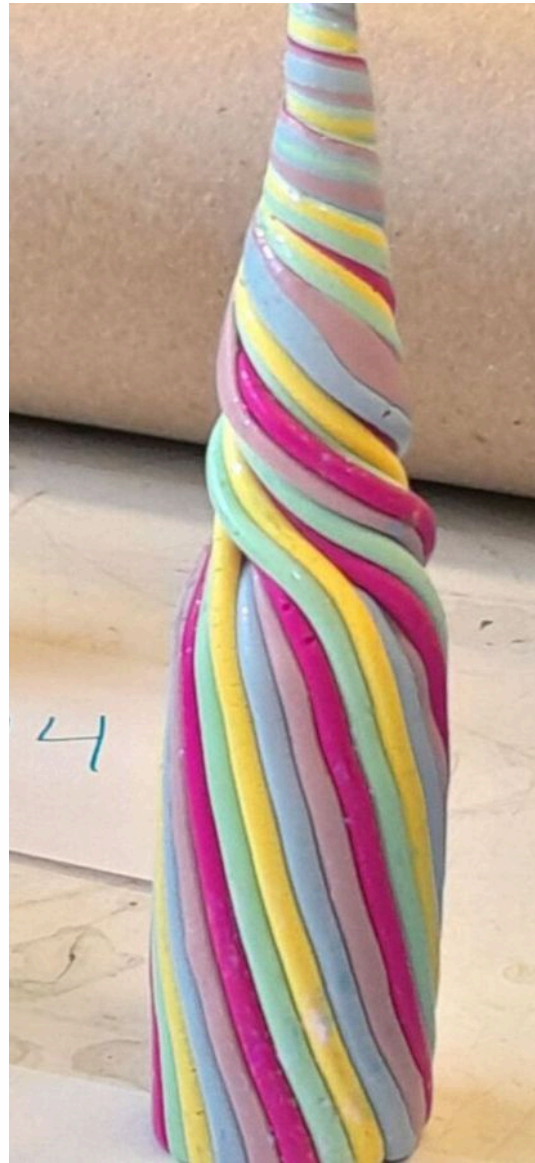
